

# Math Materials Reviewer Scores

## Guidance Document

These documents contain the aggregate scores provided by the Tennessee Advisory Panelists hired by the Tennessee Textbook and Instructional Materials Quality Commission for the mathematics instructional materials review in 2022.

Each material was required to have 100% of the academic standards present to be included on the approved list. These reports provide details on how the materials scored on Instructional Focus, Mathematical Practices, and Accessibility Features for the initial expert review findings.

During the appeals process, many publishers chose to address their areas of deficit in these areas of the rubric. These revisions are not represented in the scores you will see. Timestamped links to the Textbook Commission Publishers appeal convening are provided if your district is interested in what each publisher addressed within their appeal. If a publisher's materials passed on first reading, there is not an appeal to view. If a publisher's materials passed on first reading, there is no link provided to view the appeal.
