<u>Serious Injuries</u> – Child care agencies are required to report any incidents involving a child in its care (including on and off-site activities) where treatment by a medical professional was necessary. It does not include instances where a medical professional examines the child but determines that no injury occurred, or treatment is not necessary.

<u>Substantiated Instances of Child Abuse</u> - There were ten instances of child abuse substantiated by the Department of Children's Services in child care agencies during the reporting period:

- Lack of Supervision (5)
- Physical Abuse (4)

<u>Child Deaths</u> – There were no child deaths in licensed child care facilities during the period.
