911 Surcharge Rate Change

Statewide 911 Surcharge Rate Increase

On March 24, 2020, the Tennessee General Assembly ratified the Tennessee Emergency Communications Board's decision to increase the 911 surcharge rate.

Effective January 1, 2021, the statewide 911 surcharge rate will increase from \$1.16 to \$1.50.

Retailers of monthly communications services, including wireline, prepaid wireless, and non-prepaid wireless telecommunications services should begin collecting the new rate on sales of these services made on or after January 1, 2021.
